The course continues to improve with more refinements on the way. Our crack Greens Team continues to impress. Thanks guys. I'll be painting new red stakes this week so please inform yourselves of your different options when you find yourself in trouble:

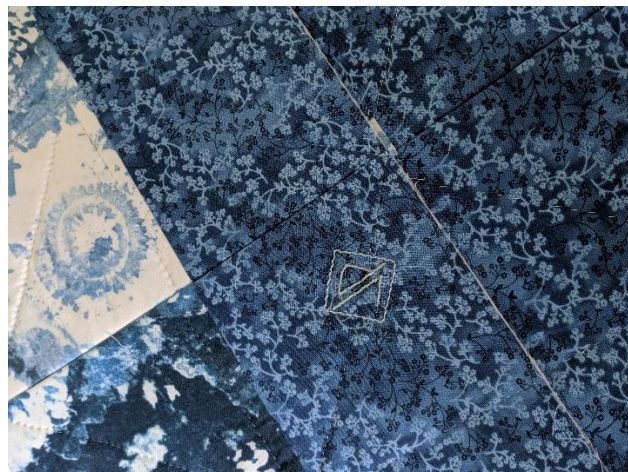
