Hello Dunany!

As you are probably aware, golf courses will be able to open for play as of May 20<sup>th</sup> 2020.

As you are also aware, golf will not be the same as usual at Dunany this summer.

The great news is that we will be able to enjoy our golf course, albeit with a few differences compared to previous years. You can expect the following when you get out on the course:

- First available Tee Time is 8:00 am....no earlier please, in order to give the crew time to safely prepare the course for you.
- No teeing off of the 8<sup>th</sup> hole...be patient and wait your turn at the 1<sup>st</sup> Tee.
- No holes on the putting green...use a ball as your target and practice to it instead.
- No benches.
- No bunker rakes.
- No water coolers (please bring your own water).
- No tee blocks.
- No garbage bins (please take your trash home and dispose of it there).
- No pull carts will be provided.
- No bathrooms available.
- The outhouse between 4 and 5 will be sanitized once per day, but no hand sanitizer or toilet paper will be provided so please bring your own.
- A new system for retrieving your ball from the cup will be installed. Use your putter to lift the metal bar up and your ball will be safely ejected from the hole. Do NOT touch the flagstick!

These changes have been made in order to minimize the risks of having common touch points with the interest of the health and well being of our membership and employees alike.

I toured the course today and am pleased with how the course is coming along. There is still some work left to finish up the drainage project on the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole and once that has been finished and the area cleaned up then Chris and Rhys will be able to get to the business of getting our turf in the best shape possible. This may take a little longer than in previous years as they are just 2 and there is much to do. Please be patient as we cross items off the "to do" list.
