On the course



It's been a banner October for golf at DCC! Here are two important items to consider as we look toward the end of the season:

- The coming week's forecast includes nights at or below freezing. Accordingly, the first available daily tee times will be 10:00 AM until the end of the season.
- As nighttime temperatures dip, it's important to protect our course by not playing when frost is present. Regular
 members will receive an email whenever frost forces a temporary course closure until the end of the season.
 Please watch for those emails on chilly mornings and follow the direction of course staff to help protect our most
 important asset. The greens crew will ask you to stop your round if you are on the course during frost conditions.
- Course closure is planned for October 31. (Harsh weather conditions may dictate an earlier closure.)

Please continue to use chronogolf to book your rounds and do not show up earlier than the opening tee times. Also, please do not start your round on tee No. 8.

And please be aware the drinking water stations on No. 3 and No. 5 have been removed for the season. Please bring your own drinking water for the remainder of the season.
