The plastic chairs that replaced them haven't enhanced the front of our new heritage clubhouse effectively, and the time has come to return the front of our clubhouse to its former glory!

These Canadian-made chairs are built to stay outdoors all year. Maintenance free. Classic design. They never fade or need paint, stain or waterproofing.

Building on the success of our "Memorial Bench Project," we will be offering members the opportunity to purchase one of 12 white "Memory Chairs" in 2024. The chair will include a plaque which can acknowledge someone who has passed, represent a family name, or a precious DCC memory, for example.

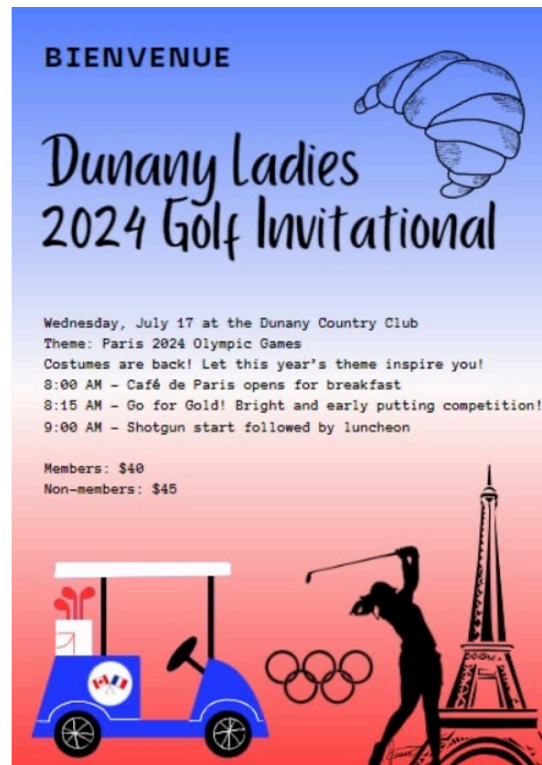
DCC Spring Clean Up (also known as Green Day) will be held on Sunday, June 2 at 1 p.m. Snacks will be provided onsite!
