

Mens' Course Record 31 by Don Sutherland

I have attached four memorable scorecards, including the hole-in-one I had playing with my dad in 1976 and the 36 on Christmas Eve 2015.

According to my mom, Sterling Babcock had a 29 when par for the course was 31, as it was until the current 2nd hole was opened for play in 1951. Bob Everson had a 33 on two occasions when the par was 35, one of them in the Husband and Wife. As a boy and teenager, I was aware that Bob Everson had the course record and I hoped to beat it some day.

At some time between 1972 and 1976, when par was 36, I had a 33 playing with Dave Eramian. I don't remember too much about it other than that I was even par after 6 holes and then pitched in from 30 yards in front of the 7th green for an eagle. I parred 8 and birdied 9 for a 33, 3 under par. I don't have a score card from this round.

On June 24, 1976, I had a 31 playing by myself. I birdied the 2nd hole and then the last 4 holes. I didn't tell anyone about it until years later when I had another 31 playing with Pierre Demers.

On June 9, 1985, playing with Stuart Neill, I had a 32 in spite of being 1 over par after 3 holes.

On a cold Ladies Day on August 9, 1989, I had a 31 playing with Pierre Demers. When we reached the 5th hole, the thermometer on the bell tower was reading 12 degrees. I left my eagle putt on the 9th green one roll short of going in for a 30. I was never a big hitter and I had my 31 without using a driver, as I didn't have one at the time.

Since then, Ed Dubiel had a 31 on his front nine in the second round when he won the Club Championship in 1990. He had 40 on the back nine. Mike Roy also had a 31 playing with his dad, but Steve doesn't remember when it was or even being aware that Mike had shot a 31.

Since then, Rod Armstrong and Stuart Neill have had 32's. I was playing with Stuart when he holed a 4-iron from the top of the hill on the 9th for a double eagle to shoot 32.
