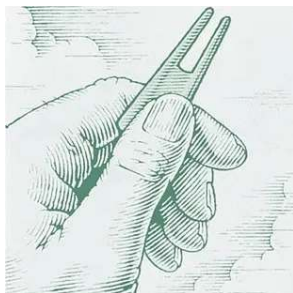

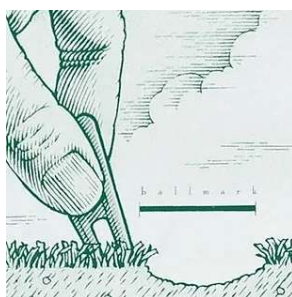

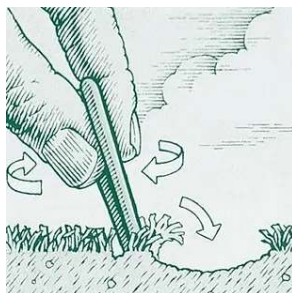
**The Proper Way to Repair a Ball Mark.** In spite of all the rain, our greens are in fantastic shape. Given all the competition going on, it's important to keep it that way, so please review the steps below and properly repair your ball marks:



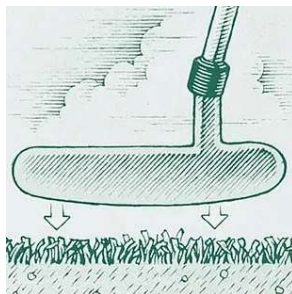
1. Use a pronged ball mark repair tool (preferably), tee or key.



2. Insert at the edges of the mark (not the middle of the depression)



3. Bring the edges together with a gentle twisting motion, but don't lift the center. Try not to tear the grass.



4. Smooth the surface with a club or foot. You're done when it's a surface that you would putt over. (Source: GCSAA)
