Information on the Fall Classic Golf Tournament on September 9th, 2017

Hello DCC members!

I wanted to send out a quick note regarding a new tournament that you may have noticed on the Fixture card this year. On September 9th, the inaugural edition of the Dunany Fall Classic is set to be played and I hope you will join us!

The tournament is a 4 person team-based format that will use handicaps to give every team a chance at winning. This format is adapted from similar tournaments at other golf clubs and these tournaments are often full of rich tradition and history with many people playing on the same teams for over a decade. I think this is a perfect format for the DCC. As far as I know, there has never been an annual 4player team tournament and this will hopefully become an amazing new annual tradition. Here are some of the details:

- Teams are chosen by themselves (can be all male, all female, or mixed)
- Scoring will use handicaps to level the playing field

Thanks and I hope to see you on the 9th!

- The 2 low net scores per hole are kept and the team with the lowest total score at the end of the tournament wins.
- Teams are encouraged to wear team colors or matching shirts/hats, etc.
- Team Captains are encouraged to host their team for a pre-tournament dinner the evening of the 8th to encourage team building, strategy and good times.
- There will be a shotgun start in the afternoon followed by a potluck dinner at the Club house. (Sign-up sheet for the potluck will be posted in the Starter Shack)

My hope is that this tournament will be something that teams look forward to participating in year after year and becomes something special to Dunany golfers. Its current name is the Fall Classic, but I'd


like to re-name the tournament for the future years to come with something meaningful to our club and
