This week's shout-out goes to our fabulous Bar Managers, **Bill Holley** and **Laurie Cruise**!

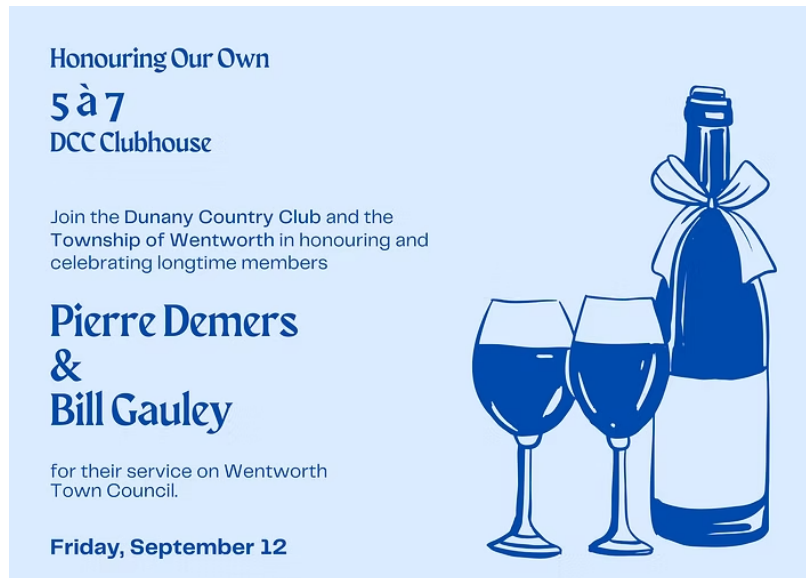
