



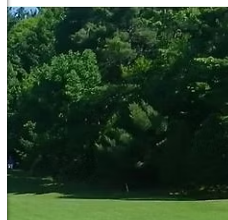

The brackets for the President's, Captain's and 4-Ball Matches are available for viewing on the Ladies Golf Program Homepage

Before match play

- Verify your scores are posted up to that day. When marking up your cards, it is important that you are playing with a current Handicap Index (the one with the decimal – do not use the Course Handicap without the decimal) and you use the Ladies Stroke Allocator to determine the handicap strokes and observe the 90% Allowance rule.
- Acquaint yourself with Rule 3 in the Rules Book and arrive at the golf course with your scorecards prepared in advance.
- Don't forget to put an identifying mark on your ball!
- Please arrange matches early in allotted time periods so that matches are played before the posted due dates.
- Read the General Reference Guide for Ladies Events for everything you need to know!

Please remember matches do not take precedence on the golf course. You must let playing groups through if you are lagging one full hole behind the group in front of you. If you notice your group lagging, please speed up play by:

- Restricting practice swings.
- Being aware of whose turn it is to play and BE READY.
- Lining up your putts and BE READY when it is your turn to putt.
- Sprinting between green and following tee.
