Club House Renovation – Quebec Grant Decision

As you know, we applied in February for a grant under Quebec’s Ministry of Sport to obtain funds to help us with our Club House renovation project. If you were at the DCA AGM, you would know that Jason Morrison, Mayor of Wentworth was very optimistic about our chances. Unfortunately, we were informed last week by Normand Fauchon, Director of the “Direction des infrastructures, des événements et de la gestion financière du loisir et du sport” that our proposal has not been granted.

We had received strong endorsements of support for our proposal from the MRC and the townships of Gore and Wentworth. **Michael Fehr** has spoken with **Jason Morrison** who is committed to continue to helping us with the project and will work with **Natalie Black**, Wentworth’s Executive Director and the MRC to try to identify other opportunities for funding.

We will also be organizing a meeting of our core fundraising and design teams to review our options.
