Caterpillar Outbreak!

Most members will have noticed an abnormally high number of caterpillars around Dunany this year. These are Eastern and Forest Tent Caterpillars which are currently experiencing an outbreak period. These critters follow a “boom-and-bust” population growth cycle, with outbreaks typically occurring every ten years. Although outbreaks are periodic, they do not usually happen on an exact schedule because they depend on several environmental and biological factors. Tent caterpillars have only one generation a year, and each female lays only a single egg mass.

Tent caterpillars are not an invasive species, and have been in North America since the 17th century. As a result, natural predators like birds and rodents as well as insect parasites will control a certain portion of the population. In late June or July, the caterpillars weave themselves into cocoons which can be found on fences, tree trunks or beneath sheltered areas like garden planter boxes. Although they can cause severe damage to deciduous trees, trees can usually bud again later in the summer once the caterpillars have moved on to the next stage of their life cycle.
